

Support of school measures

Please continue to encourage your child to:

1. Wear their mask at all times where 2 metre social distancing cannot be maintained.
2. Wash hands regularly and sanitise upon entry and exit to the school and classroom.
3. Clear their books into their locker at the end of the day to facilitate deep cleaning of the classrooms and sanitise individual locker.
4. Students are reminded that they should exit the building as soon as possible and not gather in groups.
5. Please ensure your son/daughter returns after midterm with sanitising wipes and a small bottle of hand sanitiser
